During my tenure I reached out to Muslim parents to take more active role in volunteering in the school with the objective of increasing visibility of Muslim community.

2016-17: I taught in the SRVIC Islamic School.

2020- 2021: Currently I am Finance Secretary for the San Ramon Valley Council of PTA Executive Board, Treasurer for Windemere Ranch Middle School PTA, and Mentor for Hidden Hills Elementary School PTA. I am also an active member of the San Ramon Unified School District Technology Plan committee, and I help with the refugee program of SRVIC.
